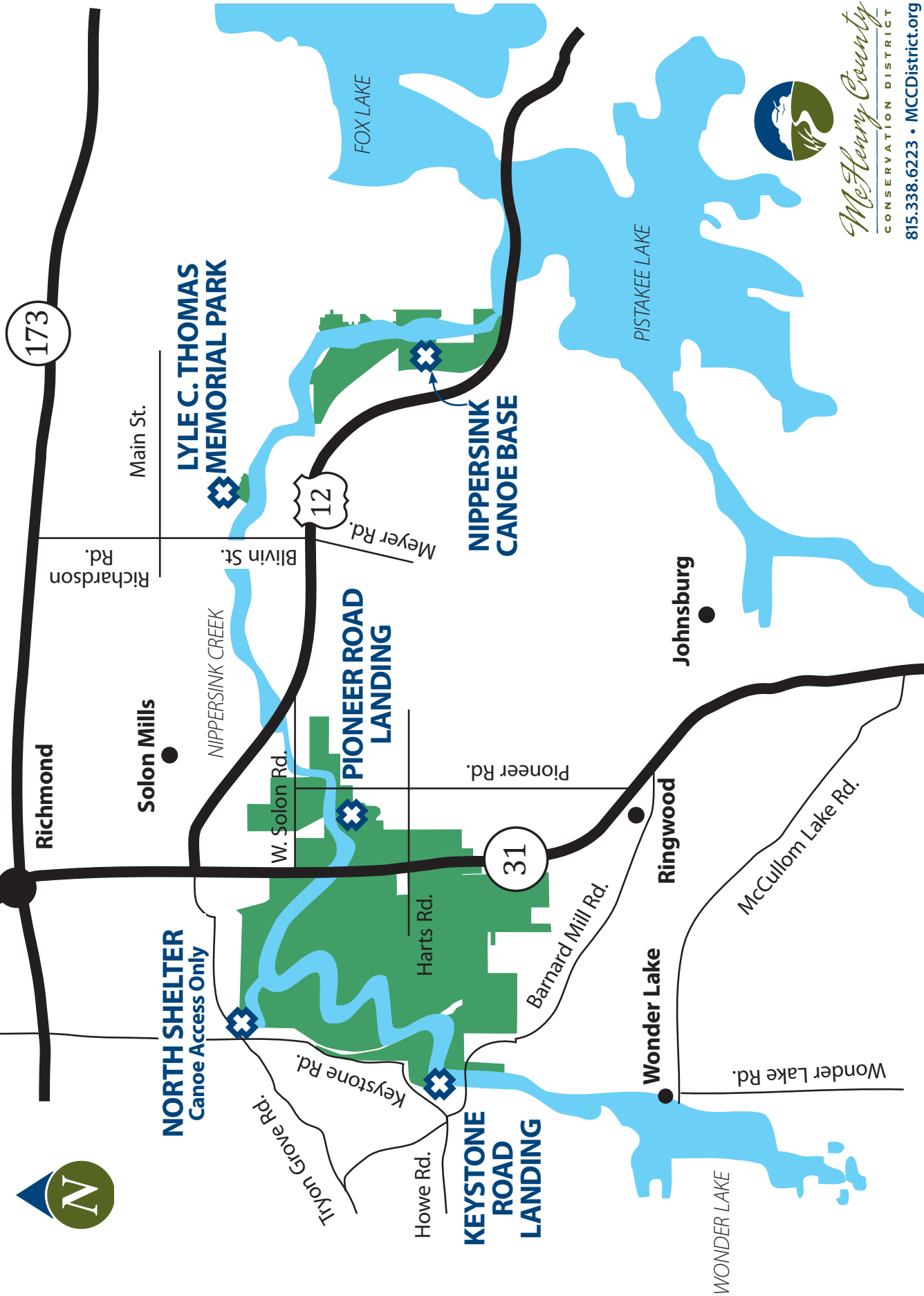

# RULES

- From Keystone Landing to just past Pioneer Landing, you will be traveling through Glacial Park—McHenry County Conservation District's largest site. After you leave its boundaries you will be passing through private property—please be respectful of your neighbors.
- If the water is high, watch for submerged logs. Also watch for cross fences and submerged wires; lift them with wooden paddles in case they are electrified. Please report any downed trees to the District office at (815) 338-6223.
- Camping at the North Shelter is accessible by canoe only, is limited to the designated area and requires an advance permit. Permits are available at the District office, fee required.
