If you are chosen in the lottery, you must attend the mandatory archery orientation meeting at McHenry County College on September 8, 2011, at 7:00 p.m.

**Instructions:** Type in all applicable information (use the TAB key to move to the next field). Print the application. If anyone is new to the MCCD Hunting Program, he/she must include a copy of his/her Hunter Safety Education Card. Mail or deliver the application to MCCD Archery Deer Hunting Program, Brookdale Office, 18410 U.S. Highway 14, Woodstock, IL 60098. Applications must be received (or postmarked if mailed) by August 11. Faxed applications will not be accepted. **Fee reduction:** Valid and complete applications postmarked **August 1** or, if delivered, received by 4:30 pm on August 1 will receive a 25% reduction in permit fees if chosen in the lottery. **If an application is missing information, it will not be considered for the fee reduction.**
